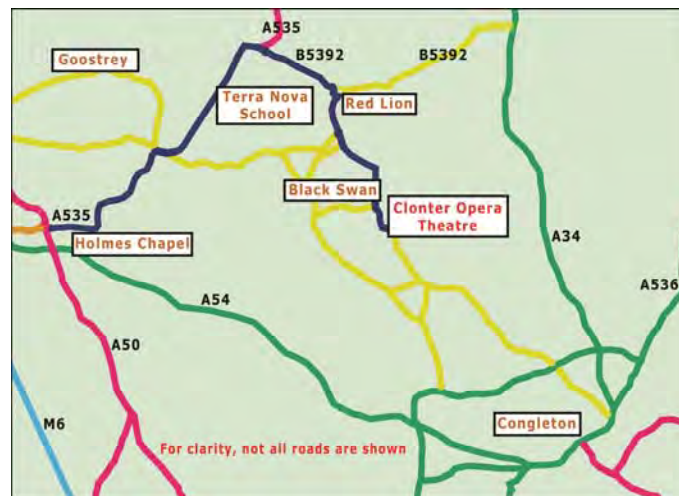

How to find us

This season, all concerts will be held at Clonter Opera Theatre, Trap Road, Swettenham Heath, Congleton, CW12 2LR. Clonter Theatre offers us first class facilities, with ample parking, very civilised toilets, a spacious foyer for socialising before the concert and in the interval, refreshments, and a comfortable auditorium with raked seating allowing a perfect view of the performers.

From Holmes Chapel, take the Macclesfield Road, A535. About a ¼ mile after the Terra Nova School, turn right towards Macclesfield (signposted Clonter Opera) on the B5392. After a mile, at Lower Withington village green, turn right onto Trap Street (signposted Clonter Opera) and right again in front of the Red Lion. After ½ mile bear left at a fork (signposted Clonter Opera) and Clonter Opera is on the left after about a mile on Trap Road (and just over ¼ mile after the Black Swan pub on the right).
